By Subway: Take #7 train to Willets Point/Shea Stadium stop. Walk through the Flushing Meadows Park towards the Unisphere direction. The museum is housed in the NYC Building in front of the Unisphere.

Free Trolley to the museum is available at 111th St stop on #7 train at 12pm, 1:30pm, and 3pm. For more info call ext. 144.

By Car from Manhattan: Take Mid-town Tunnel to LIE to Exit 22 - Grand Central Pkwy/Triborough Bridge and get off at Exit 9P on Grand Central Pkwy. Follow the signs to the museum. Free parking.
